SUMMARY OF THE PROPOSAL

Ballymun United Football Club commenced a three phased development of a dedicated soccer facility at St Margaret's Road in Ballymun (next door to IKEA) that is aligned with its mission statement, values and strategic objectives

Ballymun United's mission is to provide sporting and personal development opportunities for the youth in Ballymun and its immediate surrounds, to develop a soccer facility that will allow its members to compete at the highest level in Ireland. Ballymun is a highly populated and disadvantaged area in North Dublin, approx 3 kilometers from Dublin Airport.

The club's main objectives are;

- To promote and foster the game of association football
- To provide the youth of the Ballymun area and its immediate surrounds with an opportunity to develop their sporting and social skills.
- To provide quality leadership in all our programme's of training to enable our youth to accept responsibilities, accept themselves and be proud of who they are.
- To ensure equality of opportunity in all levels of participation in the club with a particular focus on discrimination and racism.
- To promote and carry the name Ballymun with pride throughout the sporting world.
- To undertake to make our activity as welcoming and inclusive as possible to those who wish to participate, within the spirit of the club.
- To develop the club, and its facilities, to compete at the highest level in Ireland.

The development of the facility will provide a range of sports training and recreational facilities for the use by its club members and other sports/social groups in Ballymun and the surrounding areas.

Location:

Our Complex is set in 4 hectares adjacent to the M50 motorway and St Margaret’s Road. The facility’s access road is also used by IKEA staff and customers. The facility consists of three grass pitches and one all weather training area (size 70m x 40m), further development will see a fourth grass pitch for use by the smaller age groups and extending the all weather area into a full size 4G playing area.

Clubhouse consists of a two storey building, 1,500 sq meters, which includes 6 dressing rooms, match official’s room, kitchen, medical room, storage room and reception area on the ground floor, Office, Meeting room, waiting area, ladies and gents toilets, toilet for the disabled on the upper floor, the upper floor has a social area and gym area, both of which are unfinished at present.

Plans for the future are to complete the unfinished upper floor and erect a seated area adjacent to the clubhouse along the west side of our Main Pitch.

Club History and Background

Ballymun United Football Club was formed in 1968 in a strong vibrant working class community of North Dublin. This first high rise flats complex in Ireland was built to help solve the housing crisis in Dublin city in the late sixties.

The football club was organized following street leagues which were organized between the new young tenants moving into the flats at that time.

The clubs first secretary Tommy Ronan is the Grandfather of the actress Saoirse Ronan.

The club produced the only Irish centre half to mark the great Pele , Brendan Place RIP.

The club became a vocal point for new tenants who played soccer, it was entered into the Athletic Union League in 1969 season.

Ballymun United over the past 48 years has become one of the most successful amateur soccer clubs in Ireland, having won various trophies at youth and senior level over the years, the culmination of this success came in 2001 when the club won all major trophies available to them in Ireland

- FAI Junior Cup Winners
- Leinster FA Junior Cup Winners
- Athletic Union League Premiership title
- Athletic Union League Premier Cup
- John Bagster Trophy (Cross Border Tournament)

Ballymun United's performance was in no doubt the greatest achievement by any amateur club in the history of the sport in the country.

The Club currently operates with three senior teams and eleven youth teams, 260 playing members at present.

We hope to expand these numbers by 30% next season.

We have had numerous players over the years who represented their country at amateur level, five ex Ballymun players have gone to sign for English clubs;
